

# **ICU**

## **Rules: Grades 4th-12th**

- 1. Those students that have ANY missing assignments will be remanded to ICU. I or Mrs Bubbers will check each day at 8am. If you are on the list at this time you will not be taken off for any reason. This means you will not ask teachers to correct a paper or take you off the list because you handed the assignment in prior to lunch. This is not a punishment but a chance for you to get caught up on your work so take advantage of it!!!**

**2. If you have 5 or more assignments missing at any one time you will automatically stay after school.**
